How to launder School Uniforms

School uniforms which contain woollen fibre

- School pinafore dress
- o Woollen cardigan
- Woollen vest

The important points to be remembered in washing and ironing wool to avoid shrinkage and felting are:

- 1. use an even temperature of washing and rinsing waters;
- 2. use water at 40°C or less;
- 3. use mild detergent e.g. woolite, downy washing liquid, etc.;
- 4. avoid rubbing the garment;
- 5. spin-dry for the pinafore dress, hang to dry;
- 6. roll in a towel to remove moisture for the knitted cardigan and vest, never hand-wring, garments made from knitted fabrics in all fibres or mixtures of fibres should be dried flat;
- 7. iron with correct temperature by adjusting the iron to the wool setting, cover the woollen garment with a white cotton cloth when ironing, press and slide the iron slowly on the garment to obtain the best result.

Before washing:

- 1. empty pockets;
- 2. have stains removed before laundering;
- 3. be mended or darned (mend broken seams, take up loose hems and sew on loose buttons).

Hand washing

- 1. Washing: squeeze and knead the garment in warm soapy water, do not rub.
- 2. Rinsing: squeeze and knead the garment in warm water and rinse sufficiently several time to remove traces of soap.
- 3. Roll in a towel to remove moisture.

Machine washing

- 1. Fold and put woollen garments into laundry bags of appropriate size.
- 2. Set the washing machine to the wool cycle when washing woollen garments.

* Never apply chlorine bleach to the summer cardigan.
